SHAWNEE SHOTGUN CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

The following rules are hereby established by the membership of the Shawnee Shotgun Club Inc. (SSC), as a means of governing the conduct of members, member guests and/or attendees of club-sponsored functions while on the premises of the SSC.

- 1. When on club property, all persons are expected to refrain from engaging in the following, under any circumstances:
 - a. Willful destruction of club property and/or the personal belongings of any individual on the club's premises.
 - b. Theft of club property or the personal belongings of any individual on the club's premises.
 - c. Intimidating, threatening, abusive or overly obnoxious behavior.
 - d. Repeated use of gross, lewd, profane, abusive and sexually explicit language or acts for any reason.
 - e. The use of language or display of behavior that would be discriminatory in nature, specifically directed toward or at another individual while on the club grounds.
 - f. Fighting, wrestling or the use of physical force that would or could cause bodily harm to any individual
 - g. Distribution of an alcoholic beverage to a minor
 - h. Use and/or distribution of illegal drugs while on club grounds.
 - i. Consumption of alcohol before or during the use of firearms.
 - j. Guests of members are also responsible for the adherence to these rules while on club property, and it is the members' responsibility to ensure compliance. Member will be held responsible and subject to penalty and/or BOD discipline.
 - k. Driving any vehicle on property in such a manner where it causes a safety risk to any person or property.

Any and all individuals will strictly adhere to all safety and firearm rules while on the club's premises. Infractions of the above will be grounds for immediate suspension and removal from the SSC grounds.

CLAY BIRD SPORTS SHAWNEE SHOTGUN CLUB RANGE RULES

- 1. Eye and ear protection MUST be worn while on the course and in any designated shooting area at ALL times, even if you are not shooting. Please remind your squad-mates if someone is not wearing their safety glasses.
- 2. **NEVER TRY TO FIX A TRAP MACHINE**. Notify the Manager on Duty IMMEDIATELY of any trap problems or safety issues.
- 3. NO alcoholic beverages are allowed on the course or in any designated shooting area. No one will be allowed to participate in any shooting activity if deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, whether prescription or illicit.
- 4. Shooters may only load their shotgun when in the station and feet firmly planted and the target area is deemed clear and safe. When NOT in a shooting station, shotguns MUST be unloaded and placed in a rack or carried vertical with the action open, preferably with the muzzle to the ground.
- 5. When leaving a station or shooting area, shooters MUST ensure that their shotgun is unloaded, the action is open, and carried in a vertical position.
- 6. Shooters of Automatic and pump guns must pick up all hulls unless they possess a disability where they could not do so.
- 7. DO NOT SHOOT AT THE MACHINES OR DOWN RANGE EQUIPMENT FOR ANY REASON, NO MATTER WHAT THE WIND DOES OR WHERE A TARGET MAY BLOW. MACHINES ARE \$3200.00 EACH AND BATTERIES ARE \$300.00 EACH. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR WHAT YOU SHOOT DOWN RANGE.
- 8. Practice swings must be with the muzzle down range, DO NOT TAKE PRATICE SWINGS THAT ARE NOT DOWN RANGE.
- 9. LOAD ONLY TWO (2) SHELLS IN THE GUN AT ANY ONE TIME
- 10. The largest shot size permitted is #7½ (#8, #9 shot are also allowed NO #6 shot or larger.)
- 11. All shots MUST be taken from within a shooting station. Shooting from anywhere else including "next to" or "in front of" a station is STRICTLY PROHIBITED!!! Wheel chair shooters are the ONLY shooters permitted to shoot from a position directly adjacent to a station when it is deemed safe. If hoop courses are out, the hoops are considered the shooting station. Do not walk beyond the hoops at any time.
- 12. NEVER handle another shooter's gun without their permission.
- 13. NO shooting at any live game!!!
- 14. Drivers of any golf cart/ATV MUST possess a valid driver's license. If you have brought your own cart you must possess your own liability insurance for said cart.

- 15. No golf cart/ATV speeding allowed. Speeding is considered driving faster than a person jogging or staff's judgment. Speeders will be asked to leave for the day with NO refund. NO WARNINGS will be given!!!
- 16. All cart traffic must yield to walking patrons.
- 17. All golf cart/ATV riders MUST be seated. No hanging or standing on the back or side of a golf cart/ATV. No more than four (4) riders per golf cart.
- 18. Always park off to the side of the path, leaving enough room for others to pass safely.
- 19. All guns MUST be field/competition shotguns, i.e. no pistol grips or collapsible stocks; 24" barrel length minimum. ABSOLUTELY NO MAGAZINE FED SHOTGUNS.
- 20. Skipping stations is only permitted if you are passing two (2) empty stations ahead and not cutting in front of other shooters. There is NO skipping stations on busy days...it is NOT fair to other shooters.
- 21. STAY on the course trail. NEVER walk off the trail for any reason. If there is a problem, notify Range Management immediately.
- 22. Shotguns MUST be carried vertically on golf carts/ATVs. No horizontal gun racks allowed for obvious safety reasons.
- 23. Clay Bird Sports LLC & Shawnee Shotgun Club is not responsible for any damages to your person or any equipment that falls off of a golf cart/ATV for any reason.
